Axe the Housing Act meeting 19th Nov – action decided:

- 1. Until it's dead, it's still alive the Housing Act remains a threat as long as it is on the books, and we will continue to demand it is repealed.
- 2. Our Autumn statement for Homes ready for launch on Wed 23, with some changes suggested. Philip to draft press release for Mon 21<sup>st</sup>. Note latest figures on costs of temporary housing and of improvement work to Buckingham Palace
- 3. Clare will check out details for lobby of housing minister and report back.
- 4. We are taking part in campaign for council housing on site of Holloway prison (now emptied). Agreed to find out other public land sites and plan co-ordinated campaigning on using these for homes.
- 5. London Mayor meetings with 'stakeholders' 21 Nov. Organised to cover these, leaflet and report back. Further 'community' consultation over London plans, in Jan/Feb.
