Everyone needs a home they can afford. Government continues to destroy council housing. Woeful public funding and inflated land prices choke off much-needed cooperative housing.

Street homelessness

and insecurity is soaring, and millions are trapped in expensive, insecure private renting. People pay over half their income in rent – while landlords and developers get tax breaks and subsidies.

Opposition in and outside Parliament stalled much of the Housing and Planning Act 2016, including Pay to Stay and selling off of council homes on the

open market. But the Act is law, used to deregulate housing associations and attack Gypsy and Traveller rights. It is still a threat.

Join us to help create a united housing movement. It's what we need to challenge this weak Government, take direct action and force the changes we need.
