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## CONTROL RENTS AND SERVICE CHARGES SECURE HOMES FOR ALL

The government's HOUSING AND PLANNING ACT 2016 threatens housing association tenants' and leaseholders' rights. The Act is tearing up rules that protect residents. Housing associations are becoming like private landlords.

From 6th April 2017
housing associations can:
Sell properties at will, even the homes we're living in
Sell our homes to private companies
Change their constitutions – the first

step to privatisation

 Avoid having local councillors on their boards, so side-step public scrutiny
 Means-test households to increase rents where combined incomes are £31,000 (£40,000 in London)

Instead of public investment to fix the housing crisis, the government is freeing housing associations to increase rents and service charges and build out-ofreach homes for sale and rent. Housing association bosses are lobbying hard for an end to rent controls by 2020. If you are a housing association tenant, shared owner or leaseholder, join us.
