Unless homes are made safe, 'stay put' means more deaths. Grenfell exposed the risks:

- Flammable cladding
- Failing fire doors
- Faulty construction and poor maintenance
- Deregulation and privatisation
- Demolition threats
- Funding cuts
- Landlords that don't care and won't listen.

After Grenfell the Prime Minister promised replacement of all unfit cladding, with Government funding if needed. It still hasn't happened.

Schools, hospitals and student blocks, building workers and neighbourhoods are also threatened.
