# Join the National day of Action on Empty Homes Saturday 9 October 2021

**Campaign Against Empty Homes, a broad coalition of organisations, is calling on local communities and national organisations to get involved in this National Day of Action.**

- More than 100,000 families are living temporary accommodation while over half a million homes have no permanent resident. Many more are living in overcrowded accommodation.
- The Climate emergency demands refurbishment, not demolition. Retrofitting 270,000 long term empty homes and council estates can help solve the climate crisis and cut energy costs for those on the lowest incomes.
- The wrong kind of housing is being built for wealth investments rather than providing permanent low-cost homes for people. There are now over 260,000 second homes with no permanent residents and at least 120,000 Airbnb type whole house lets.
