 Stop the Evictions!Demand the Government funds a rent freeze!

THE COST OF LIVING CRISIS is the cost of greed crisis. While across the UK millions of people are struggling to cover their basic needs due to rising prices and inadequate benefits, landlords and property developers are still fully protected by this government.

The Scottish government has frozen rents to help tenants, but in England, four million social tenants face 7\% rent rises from April 2023, and there is no cap at all for private renters.

Housing should be a key component of the welfare state. Really affordable rents and security in our homes are just as important as the number of homes being built. We still have unaffordable private blocks being built while this dysfunctional housing market squeezes out ordinary people. If Scotland can do it, so can we.
We demand a government rent and service charge freeze across all rental sectors, at least until April 2024. This should include the rental element for shared owners. The government must fully fund the rent freeze for council tenants and ensure there is no loss of services in the social rented sector as a whole.
